Policy Area: Instruction: G2

Policy Subject: **CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT & COORDINATION**

The Addison Northeast Supervisory Union School Board and its member school district boards recognize their responsibility for the improvement and growth of the educational program of the schools. For the purposes of this policy, curriculum is defined as all planned learning activities within the school district's jurisdiction.

The school board delegates the direct responsibility for developing and evaluating the curriculum to the superintendent as the educational leader of the Addison Northeast Supervisory Union, who shall establish procedures to ensure effective participation of all professional staff members, students as appropriate, parents and others who have a direct interest in the school. Principals of each school will be responsible for the development and implementation of the school-based curriculum and shall ensure that the curriculum is consistent with Vermont's Framework of Standards and Learning Opportunities, the Vermont Grade Expectations, and the ANESU Priority Learning Expectations. The superintendent shall be responsible for curriculum coordination among all schools of the Addison Northeast Supervisory Union, PreK-12.

The superintendent shall be responsible for the development, coordination, and evaluation of the curriculum. The superintendent shall ensure that the curriculum is consistent with the school district mission as approved by the school board.

The superintendent shall conduct systematic evaluations of all programs within the curriculum and periodically report the results to the board.
